



Paper Snowflake Folding Template

1. Fold page in half on dotted line
2. fold left third behind on dotted line
3. fold right third in front on dotted line
4. Fold the pie shaped piece in half on dotted line
5. Cut off excess at an angle even with shortest edge
6. Cut shapes from both folded edges. Triangles or curved triangles from alternating sides is a good way to start.
7. Carefully unfold
8. Iron lightly with warm iron to minimize creases.
9. Optional: laminate and trim

It is only necessary to print and fold this template once. Additional snowflakes can be folded using this as a guide if you leave this one uncut. All purpose printer/copier paper works fine for this project but young children and those with less strength in their hands will find it easier to cut a thinner paper such as tracing paper or inexpensive giftwrapping paper.
